

Making the Most of Student Impact  
What We Can Do To Join God As He Moves

1. Consider Student Impact as part of God's movement through and in Yorktown, VA as he draws people like you to Himself.
  - a. Bring Your Bible and a pen
  - b. Be joyful and thankful (1 Thess. 5:13, 18)
  - c. Be prayerful (1 Thess. 5:17)
    - i. Pray for God to move
    - ii. Pray for the teacher
    - iii. Pray for Truth to be made known and loved
    - iv. Pray for God to be glorified
  - d. Do Not quench the Holy Spirit (1 Thess. 5:19)
  - e. Abstain from every form of evil (1 Thess. 5:22)
  - f. Expect God to Move
  - g. Be willing to be used by God as He speaks to others and to you
  
2. Build encouraging community with other students
  - a. Care about people.
  - b. Pray for individual students.
    - i. Ask others how you could pray for them
  - c. Be at peace with one another (1 Thess. 5:13)
  - d. Seek to do good to one another (1 Thess. 5:15)
  - e. Be inclusive of others
  - f. Get to know people outside of your normal group
  
3. Encourage the leaders
  - a. Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they are keeping watch over your souls, as those who will have to give an account. ***Let them do this with joy and not with groaning, for that would be of no advantage to you.*** Hebrews 13:17
  - b. Be Active listeners
  - c. Respect and appreciate the leaders for their work (1 Thess. 5:12-13a)
  - d. Tell us what you are learning about God
  - e. Come to Student Impact with the goal of encouraging
