1. Why did God give us bodies and material things? (p. 119)

2. Piper argues that both marriage and singleness can be idolatrous. (pg. 120) What might idolatry look like in each of these? Conversely, what does Christ-exalting marriage or singleness look like?

3. Piper reminds readers that we are living in the last days, indicating stressors and difficulties in daily life are inevitable. How should we then live among our spiritual family? (pp. 121-122)

4. How is hospitality an act of stewardship? (pp. 122-123)

5. Christian hospitality is a reflection of God's grace extended to us in Christ. Paul tells us in Romans 15:7 to "welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you." How does hospitality look different to the world than to the believer?

6. How can you better embrace hospitality in your life and home?
