1. What is Tozer referring to in this statement? "The moral shock suffered by us through our mighty break with the high will of heaven has left us all with a permanent trauma affecting every part of our nature. There is disease in both in ourselves and in our environment." What does this lead us to do?
2. Explain the following quote. "It is possible to have some truth in the mind without having the Spirit in the heart, but it is never possible to have the Spirit apart from truth." (Tozer, 104)
3. What took place in Isaiah 6 when God's holiness was revealed? What do you make of Tozer's statement, "Such an experience cannot but be emotionally violent?"
4. What are the "twin concepts?" (Tozer, 105)
5. What has God made the "moral condition necessary to the health of His universe?" What is your reaction? (Tozer, 106)
6. What does God have to do to preserve His creation?
7. How can we be holy? "since it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy."(I Peter 1:16)
